Regular Meeting

October 14, 2024

1. The meeting was called to order by Miller at 5:31 p.m.  
Present were Marc Miller, Trustee, via remote; Paula Crook, Clerk; Chris Carlson, Treasurer; Township Residents; Township employees.
2. After a review of the minutes of the September 9, 2024 meeting, Miller asked if there was a motion to approve the minutes. A motion was made by Carlson with a second by Crook to approve the minutes. Miller, Crook and Carlson voted to approve the minutes. Motion carried 3-0.
3. **Township Auditing Board**  
The beginning balance in the accounts is \$509,856.04. There were disbursements of \$117,677.38 and receipts of \$46,672.57 leaving an ending balance of \$438,851.23. Expenses were for finishing up existing road contracts, payroll and the bond payment. Carlson asked for a motion to approve the treasurer's report. There was a motion by Miller with a second by Crook. Miller, Crook and Carlson voted to approve the report. Motion carried 3-0.
4. **Board of Highway Commissioner / Road Overseer Report**  
The Township is finishing projects that were already budgeted for the year. The last project is Crest Ridge, mill and overlay. Carlson is taking projects to assess for 2025. Mowing is slowing down and maintenance picking up.
5. **Old Business** – There is no old business.
6. **New Business**  
The Township received a notice from Sedgwick County clerk's office. The letter stated that "there was a refund processed that affects the Township's distribution. Minneha will not be receiving any ad valorem taxes this time due to a refund of a court of tax appeals. Your taxing authority didn't have enough taxes collected to cover the refund that was processed. You should be receiving more ad valorem taxes in January 2025". Carlson stated that this is similar to what happened last year when the county gives us a budget and we fail to collect that budget. It must have been a significant refund because we usually get one in October and December. No ad valorem will be coming from the county until January 2025. This affects future projects until Carlson knows more. Projects already under contract will be evaluated.
7. **Adjournment** – Miller asked for a motion to adjourn. A motion was made by Carlson with a second by Crook to adjourn the meeting at 5:37 p.m. Miller, Crook and Carlson approved the motion, 3-0.
